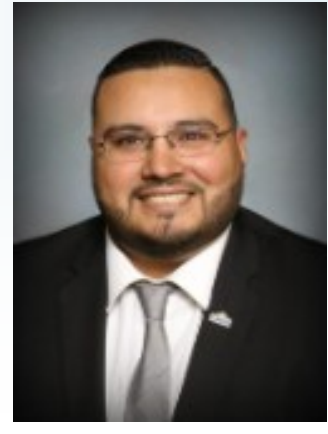

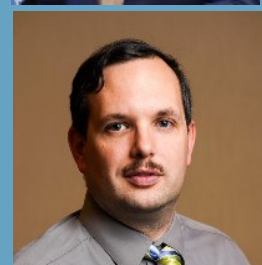

Alfredo is the Co-Founder of ReEngine Consulting and a PhD candidate at George Washington University in Washington, DC. He has been a military commander, diplomat, and assistant professor of history at West Point Military Academy.

He has held positions at the federal, state, and city level as a public executive and an improvement expert, to include Manager of Community Affairs for Texas and Director of Business Transformation at Texas Workforce Commission for 7 years.
